	<b>Pinot Grigio, Verdissimo “Organic”</b> (Italy) 22 <i>Alluring citrus bouquet with vanilla undertones. Tangy and crisp fruit flavors.</i>
	<b>Merlot, Eco Balance “Sustainable”</b> (Chile) 22 <i>Rich notes of plum and vanilla.</i>
	<b>Pecorino, Saladini Pilastrini “Organic”</b> (Italy) 23 <i>Bright acidity showing flavors of yellow fruits &amp; nuts.</i>

## Wines That Give Back

These wineries donate a portion of their sales to various charities

	<b>Cashmere, Cline “Rhone Blend”</b> (California) 30 <i>Very flavorful, smooth, offering big cherry, raspberry and chocolate notes with hints of cracked black pepper and plum.</i>  (Donates proceeds to “Living with Breast Cancer” a program helping people receiving treatment for, or recovering from, breast cancer)
	<b>Moscato, Middle Sister</b> (California) 22 <i>Rich impression entering the mouth with prominent floral notes. Soft mid-palate; good acidity on the finish. Fruit flavors of peaches, pears and citrus linger.</i>  (Donates proceeds to women and children in need)
	<b>Tenacious Red, Purple Cowboy</b> (California) 24 <i>Berry flavors explode in the mouth with cinnamon and cassis in the mid-palate leading to slight cocoa powder tannins on the finish. A very rich, full-bodied style.</i>  (Supports programs for breast cancer research as well as provides support for families coping with the disease)
